### OVERVIEW

Each fall, EdVestors' \$100,000 School on the Move Prize recognizes one of the most improving Boston Public Schools. Acknowledging the tremendous effort that school communities put in to ensure every student in Boston receives an equitable, meaningful education, we seek to shine a light on those schools, leaders, and teachers who create and continuously improve learning environments where all students thrive, demonstrated through significantly improved outcomes for students.

The School on the Move Prize has evolved since it was launched in 2006, as the EdVestors team has refined the criteria, selection process, and efforts to document and share strategies from the most improving schools in Boston. The Prize is awarded based on the following three criteria: Evidence of Improvement, Focus on Equity, and Relevance to Other Schools. By sharing the stories of how schools improve, we hope to help more schools make significant progress for their students.

The 20th Annual School on the Move Prize Ceremony will take place on Thursday, November 13th at the 521 Overlook at Fenway Park. Generally, over 300 guests attend the Ceremony each year in person to share a deep commitment for school improvement efforts.
