Delivering high quality education takes hard work and determination. Each fall, EdVestors hosts the Thomas W. Payzant School on the Move Prize to recognize this hard work and celebrate the teachers, leaders, and schools that have significantly improved outcomes for their students. We share the stories of how schools are able to improve in an effort to help more schools make significant progress for their students. The prestigious School on the Move Prize comes with a \$100,000 award from EdVestors, public recognition, and the opportunity for the winning school to document and share replicable strategies.

Through the Prize selection process, we seek to understand how and why certain schools are able to accelerate student achievement. Each year, a blue-ribbon panel of leaders selected from a cross-section of Boston's business, philanthropic and education sectors dives deep into the stories of these rapidly improving schools and selects one winner and two finalists. We incorporate a case study of the winning school from the previous year and what we've learned throughout the selection process into the rest of our work. We do this to help more schools make significant progress to improve education outcomes for all students.

Our 2017 award ceremony at the Westin Waterfront Hotel on Wednesday, November 1<sup>st</sup> will draw more than 300 guests who share a deep commitment to urban education and Boston's future.
