Each fall, EdVestors hosts the Thomas W. Payzant School on the Move Prize. We honor the bright spots in Boston Public Schools and celebrate the hard work of teachers and school leaders who have significantly improved outcomes for their students. We share the stories of how schools improve to help more schools make significant progress. The prestigious School on the Move Prize comes with a \$100,000 award from EdVestors, public recognition, and the opportunity for the winning school to document and share replicable strategies.

Each year, a blue-ribbon panel of leaders selected from a cross-section of Boston's business, philanthropic, and education sectors dives deep into the stories of these rapidly improving schools and selects one winner and two finalists.

The 2020 School on the Move Prize Ceremony will take place on **Wednesday**, **October 28th**. Generally, 300 guests attend the Ceremony each year in person to share a deep commitment. In this time during COVID-19, we are planning to host the event virtually and look forward to drawing a larger audience.
