Each fall, the \$100,000 School on the Move Prize recognizes one of the most improving Boston Public Schools. Acknowledging the tremendous effort needed to ensure every student in Boston receives a world-class education, we seek to shine a light on those schools, leaders, and teachers who create and continuously improve learning environments where all students thrive, demonstrated through significantly improved outcomes for students.

Like many aspects of our lives over the past year, the 2021 Prize will be different in a few ways. We opened this year's invitation to apply to many formerly eligible schools from over the past five years. Through this year's Prize, we'll share lessons learned from the past year of remote and hybrid learning and spotlight the key levers to aid the recovery and reimagining of learning in the coming years.

The 2021 School on the Move Prize Ceremony will take place in October 2021. Generally, 300 guests attend the Ceremony each year in person to share a deep commitment. Due to the pandemic, we are still finalizing the event date and format.
